



Welcome to our second Decidedly Jazz Production. Our goal this year is very simply to present examples of the wide range of styles and eras that constitute the amazing phenomenon called Jazz.

We would like to extend a very special thank-you to the countless musicians, dancers, students and audience members who have taken time to 'speak into the Decidedly Jazz microphone.' For the past year and a half we have been filling dozens of tapes with their reactions to questions and statements such as: "What is Jazz?", "What is Jazz to you?", "Talk about Jazz", "Use five words to describe it", and "How does it make you feel?"

The highly edited tape used in the performance focusses on the answers which surfaced time and time again. We posed the question, "What is Jazz?" without the expectation of arriving at a definitive answer. 




