

NOTES FROM THE ARTISTIC DIRECTOR

School touring has always held a vital and integral place in Decidedly Jazz's season programming, and we have regularly been told by the adults attending these 'designed for youth' productions that they enjoy the performances as much as the kids. In response to the countless requests that we have received over the years to do public presentations of our youth programming, we have decided to include our new (and first ever) high school production, LOCKER-SLAMMIN' NAVEL GAZIN' AND RANDOM LEAPS OF FAITH in our current season.

I must admit that I was quite terrified entering the previously uncharted waters of designing a DJD show for high school students. After all, it has been several decades since I was a teen and it seemed that the issues that today's teens are facing are huge and numerous. What could we do that would hold their interest and speak to them in a meaningful and entertaining way ?

We decided to start by talking to the students themselves, and Lana Skauge's recorded interviews with an interesting cross-section of junior high, senior high and University students formed the basis for the soundscape of the show as well as its theme... choices

The interviews were fascinating. I was moved by the honesty, candidness, humour and depth of many of the statements made. It seems that 'GENERATION?' is a generation filled with budding philosophers.

Once the interviews were completed, the form and spirit of the production seemed to dictate itself, the result being the FREE-STYLE FUNKIN' MULTIPLE CHOICE ADVENTURE of questions and dances that you are about to experience.
